

Graduation loan

Information and application for the granting of a graduation Loan

Guidelines for the Award of the Deutsches Studierendenwerks DSW

On behalf of the Deutsches Studierendenwerk e.V. (DSW), the umbrella organisation of all 57 student unions in Germany, the Studierendenwerk grants a graduation loan.

The funds from the „hardship fund“ represent a bridging financial aid that is intended to enable the successful completion of studies.

You should first read through the [guidelines](#) to see if you belong to the eligible target group.

Purpose of the loan

- For students in an economic emergency situation to secure their livelihood as well as the Living expenses as well as study costs incurred for the completion of studies
- **Cannot be used** for purposes unrelated to studies (medical treatment costs, maintenance to third parties, repayment of existing liabilities)

Loan amount

- Maximum of 12 times the BAföG maximum rate, i.e. a maximum of 934 euros per month

Disbursement, term, repayment

- Payment in monthly instalments, at most up to the BAföG maximum rate
- Maximum 60 months, from the date of the first payment
- Repayment from the 7th month after granting the last loan instalment
- Repayment in instalments is possible, with a minimum instalment of 55 euros
- The loan is granted **interest-free**

Application and advice

- Your application must be submitted in person to the Social Counselling Office of the Studierendenwerk Vorpfalz - Xylanderstraße 17 - 76829 Landau in Pfalz - Tel. ++49 6341-9179-180 / 182.
- You can only apply if you can present the signed and [certified guarantee](#) of a third party.

Decision

- There is no legal entitlement to the loan. The loan is granted according to the proven need of the available funds, taking into account your projected degree.
